#### A Note from Pastor Rich...

Existence After Death...

Death is a curious topic. Books are written about it, businesses are built around it, and most people would rather avoid it. But what does it mean to die? Ask the retired M.D. or R.N. in our community and they will give the medical definition. Ask someone literal in the Bible and they will have a God definition.

Think about it. Sixty million people will die worldwide this year. Of that, two and one half million will be from the United States.

Jesus has plenty to say about death, and His church needs to help people think about what happens after death. When a Christian speaks about their understanding of death, it can be an opportunity to be a witness.

Listen to the frankness of Joseph in Genesis 50:24, "soon I will die." Joseph had a confidence regarding this event, and he gave specific instructions to his brothers. As Jesus faced death, He agonized. He even asked if this could be averted.

What I'm suggesting is that Christians can use this issue as a talking point for starting conversations that may lead to deeper conversations about a person's need for Jesus.

Paul reminded Christians that while we live in these earthly bodies we groan and sigh, but it's not that we want to get rid of these bodies that clothe us. Rather we want to put on our new bodies so that these dying bodies will be swallowed up by life. (2 Corinthians 5:4)

The reality is most people have no idea what is after death. That is why speaking about this subject can be a conversation that shows we care and that God has answers to life!
